Mohali boasts of a major cricket ground, the PCA stadium where many international matches are held. Rock Garden, Sukhna Lake, Le Corbusier Centre are some of top attractions of City.

Weather: Weather during first week of April will be around 25 to 30 °C during day time and 19-20 °C in Night.

Travel Information: IISER Mohali is situated in Sahibzada Ajit Singh (SAS) Nagar, which is located next to the city of Chandigarh. Chandigarh is well connected to Delhi and Mumbai by air, and to Delhi by train. If you plan to travel to Chandigarh by train, then Shatabdi express would be a good choice. IISER Mohali is 12kms away from Chandigarh Railway Station and 07 kms from Chandigarh Internation Airport. IISER Mohali is located on left side of main road at the Intersection of road goes to Chandigarh and International Airport while traveling from Airport.
